New this year:

9 & 18-Hole Club Championship Matches process: This year, there will be the opportunity to indicate that you do or do not want to play in these matches on your registration form. If you do want to play, we will have a 9 & 18-hole qualifier where you're automatically entered. For your scores on the Tuesdays of May 14

& May 21, we will take your best score. The 10-best scores qualify for continued play in the tournament *9-hole match until a winner is determined. 9-hole match is handicapped. 18-hole match qualifier will run June 11 & June 18. Again the 10-best scores will be determined and the match will continue until winner. The final *18-hole match will be 36-holes.

*You will have 2-weeks to complete your matches to move to the next round. The matches will be dated.

Here are some other things to remember:

In order to meet WSGA compliance

1. A hole-in-one needs to be attested
2. You'll need to post scores hole by hole instead of total
3. We can no longer sign one name for tee times. All names of your group must be included to sign up
4. You can sign up as a twosome, but know that any single men's club member *and/or* the public can join your group.
5. Singles can no longer sign up to play alone. Either form a group with others, or look for openings with other two or threesomes.
6. Don't forget to put suggestions in the suggestion box on the table where you put your scorecards. These will be shared at Tuesday Business Meetings.
